

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Key themes of today's event

These arise from our draft strategic direction:

- **Promoting national products** – eLearning programmes, NLMS (OLM eLearning), NHS eLearning portal (*coming soon ...*)
- **Encouraging collaborative working**, e.g. across NHS organisations and between the NHS and Higher Education
- **Sharing good practice and innovation**

Major national development

- Department of Health set up a Technology-Enhanced Learning Strategy Development Group last summer
- The group's strategic review includes eLearning, simulation and other technology-enhanced learning systems
- The Chair of the group, Dr Stuart Carney, will be updating us this afternoon
